# Silence please!

The wonderful thing about silence (it's taken me years to be able to say that phrase!) is that the physical and spiritual senses become heightened.

I spend time tasting and noticing my food rather than wolfing it down as it barely touches the sides. I notice the spaces around me, the artwork on the walls, the colours, the sounds and scents of the beautiful countryside. I notice the presence of the Holy Spirit and sense that God might be speaking to me, sometimes challenging, sometimes comforting but always present.

I have been musing on Psalm 123 and the phrase 'so our *eyes wait upon* the LORD our God.' How do *eyes* wait upon the Lord, I wonder? What an odd phrase. It makes much more sense in another translation that reads 'so our *eyes look* to the Lord our God.'

However, it is the phrase 'eyes wait' that stuck, and I am glad it did, because it is that phrase that has helped me notice God's guiding presence more intently.

I think the challenge for every follower of Jesus is learning to wait with our eyes, until, as the verse goes on to say, 'he shows us his mercy.'

The temptation to rush, to do, to plan, to pursue, to make happen while time rushes by in a blur, is overwhelming, particularly when September hits and holidays seem like a distant dream.

So, as you move forward towards all that you have responsibility for, how will you find time to allow your eyes to wait upon the Lord our God?
